Each week, children will be asked to learn a spelling pattern through practising 8-10 spellings and complete a written activity.

Each week, children should read at least three times. At least one of these occasions should be to an adult practising their fluency (Six Ps of fluency: Pitch, Punctuation, Power, Pace, Passion, Pause).

Recalling all tables up to 12x12 is extremely important in Year 4. This will enable children to more easily tackle more complex problems towards the end of the year and in UKS2
