End of Year Data 2022-2023

End Key Stage 2 2023

Reading

Attainment at key stage 2 - 2023

83% of pupils achieved the expected standard in reading. This is significantly above the national standard (73%).

53% of pupils achieved the greater depth standard in reading. This is significantly above the national standard (29%)

Progress at key stage 2 - 2023

Key stage 2 progress in reading (4.22) was significantly above the national progress score, placing Fairford in the 96th percentile of schools in the country.

Writing

Attainment at key stage 2 - 2023

78% of pupils achieved the expected standard in writing, well above the national standard (71%).

25% of pupils achieved the greater depth standard in writing. This is significantly above the national figure of 13%.

Progress at key stage 2 - 2023

Key stage 2 progress in writing (1.9) was above the national progress score.

Mathematics

Attainment at key stage 2 - 2023

92% of pupils achieved the expected standard in mathematics. This is significantly above national (73%).

50% of pupils achieved the greater depth standard in mathematics. This is significantly above the national average of 24%.

Progress at key stage 2 - 2023

Key stage 2 progress in maths (6.28) was significantly above the national progress score, placing Fairford in the 100th percentile of schools in the country.

Reading, Writing and Maths Combined – key stage 2

67% of pupils achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics combined. This is significantly above national (59%).

14% of pupils achieved the greater depth standard in reading, writing and mathematics combined. This is significantly above the national standard (8%).

End Key Stage 1 2023

Reading

77% of pupils were working at the expected standard in reading. This is significantly above the national standard (68%).

37% of pupils achieved the greater depth standard in reading. This is significantly above the national standard (19%).

Writing

74% of pupils achieved the expected standard in writing. This is significantly above the national standard (60%).

23% of pupils achieved the greater depth standard in writing. This is significantly above the national standard (8%).

Mathematics

83% of pupils achieved the expected standard in writing. This is significantly above the national standard (70%).

26% of pupils achieved the greater depth standard in mathematics. This is significantly above the national standard (16%).

Phonics

Attainment in phonics – 2023

74% of pupils met the phonics expected standard in Year 1, compared with the national figure of 79%.

80% of pupils met the phonics expected standard by the end of Year 2, compared with the national figure of 89%.
